

Travel Compliance Letter for SmartVest[®]

To Whom It May Concern:

The SmartVest[®] Airway Clearance System is a medical device prescribed for use by the order of a physician and cleared for sale by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration, a branch of the Federal Government of the United States of America. The device is considered to be a medical necessity and should be kept with the patient at all times. It should not be stored away from the airline passenger and should not be checked in as baggage on any airline.

The United States Department of Transportation (DOT) has ruled that respiratory therapy devices (i.e. the SmartVest System) brought into the cabin of an airplane shall not count towards the limit on carry-on items.

The United States Transportation Security Administration (TSA) rules state that respiratory devices may be inspected at any and all check-in points but should not be separated from the prescribed owner.

The use of SmartVest while on a plane is not allowed due to Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) regulations. The device does not contain any parts or materials known to cause or interfere with the safe operation of a commercial aircraft.
